
INVESTING FOR THE FUTURE





With the Cold Store division, Luik Natie in Antwerp offers all necessary cooling and deep-freeze facilities for the storage and transfer of imported fresh products or the consolidation of fresh products for export. "In recent years we have grown to become the largest independent handler of refrigerated and deep-freeze containers in the port", states general manager Stefaan Verhelst.

In 2013 Luik Natie celebrated its hundredth birthday. Throughout this long period logistics and the port have continued to be at the heart of the concern's operations. The company now has expansive and modern industrial premises on the left bank at the heart of the growing port in Antwerp.

Luik Natie has four divisions which together form an integrated logistics chain for the handling, transport and storage of goods. "We profile ourselves to the whole world as the ultimate gateway to the European markets", explains Stefaan Verhelst. "Antwerp is the port that is furthest inland and has excellent transport connections with the hinterland. We offer our customers added value as a one-stop-shop with the focus on speed, quality and communication."

SEASONAL PEAKS

The Cold Store division is a very important part of Luik Natie. "Our extensive cooling and freezing facilities enable us to accom-

modate seasonal peaks without any problem", explains Werner Van Beek, commercial manager of the Cold Store division. "We have 4,500 pallet spaces for cooled storage. It is mainly perishables such as fruit, chocolate, dairy products, potatoes, and foodstuffs that are stored here. We have the same number of pallet spaces available in our deep-freeze zone. We store large quantities of fish, meat and butter here." Modern warehouse management puts the focus on the traceability of all goods. Luik Natie has also been awarded an ISO 22000 and Bio-certificate.

Xavier Haspeslagh: "In 2001 we started operating on a relatively small scale with deep-frozen storage with 8,000 pallet spaces, mainly for chicken slaughterhouses and the deep-frozen industry. Today we serve just about all niches in the food industry where totally reliable storage at a controlled temperature is a crucial requirement. Besides our enormous capacity of pallet spaces (now 63,500) we also possess separate units for chocolate, shock freezing and tempering."

HOW DOES STOCKHABO MAKE THE DIFFERENCE?

"Together with our sister company Devagel we guarantee minimal waiting times because all our loading bays are conditioned at a temperature of -18 °C and we can prepare up to 30 full loads. We also have an extremely high performing WMS and voice picking system for perfect control of data traffic. As regards accreditation we also possess the BRC, BI-BPD and HACCP automatic control certificates. We have also always operated with great flexibility

to meet the demands of our customers: on their request we have considerably increased our storage volume along with significant flexibility regarding opening hours. We also operate as a customs warehouse, and for important customers all data traffic can be automatically managed by ETC."

HISTORY: Founded in 2001 in Moeskroen with 8,000 pallet spaces. Two deep-freeze units were additionally built in two phases resulting in a capacity increase to 23,500 pallet spaces. The take-over of Devagel in 2010 saw a further doubling of the volume. In 2014 Stockhabo invested in a further deep-freeze unit with 16,500 pallet spaces.

Are you in search of a Belgian or European hub for the packaging and storage of fresh and deep-frozen products? Sivafrost has the latest technologies in-house to stay ahead of the pack as regards quality and range of services.

In Dendermonde, not far from the Port of Antwerp and in the Brussels-Ghent-Antwerp triangle, Sivafrost handles --- of fresh and deep-frozen products. "Here you can find multiple warehouses for storage between 0 and 4 C°, between 12 and 18 C° and deep-frozen products at -18 or -25 C°. This together accounts for 18,000 europallets," says Stijn Siongers of Sivafrost.

CO-PACKING FOR FROZEN FOOD

Sivafrost packs and repacks products on two fully automatic and two semi-automatic packing lines. On our fully automatic lines we work with packages between 50g and 5 kg in the standard bags as found in the shop. Our range also includes upright bags with or without zip closure. Our lines give us the capacity to pack almost 200 tonnes a day. Combinations of automatic and manual packaging are also among the options.

A HUB FOR BELGIUM AND EUROPE

Sivafrost's main customers include large companies from the chocolate, baking and potato sector. We pack according to the requirements of the (retail)customers and store products up to the time of supply to the market. We also take care of clearing customs formalities along with quality controls and certificates.

ADDED VALUE IN TRANSFORMATION

Further to our logistical activities we are continually looking to provide added value for our customers. We achieve this not only in transforming the packaging, but also with freezing and defrosting processes. With an extended shelf life these processes offer opportunities to our customers to export to areas previously beyond their reach.

"We were the first in Belgium to use RFID for storage for third parties. And we were the first to draw up an HACCP plan in our sector. In 2015 we will be preparing for the future by completing our next major extension fully in line with this philosophy.

In addition to the efficient AirStop technology already used for different applications for some time, Masterveil developed Powerstream as a revolutionary system to stop energy losses from open deep-freezers. "Here we offer a much more energy efficient alternative in comparison with traditional air curtain technology", says business manager Peter Deweerdt.

The AirStop from Masterveil keeps the conditions in two spaces separate with an 'invisible door'. "Here we refer to gases, odours, temperatures and moisture - so much more than just the temperature. Powerstream takes matters another step forward for freezers. Much energy is lost each time the door is opened to drive goods in or out."

Traditional air curtains are limited to, simply put, 'heating' or 'cooling' the problem. "Our Powerstream invention – developed in cooperation with Ghent University - reduces air curtain energy consumption by up to factor ten. This represents gigantic savings", adds Peter Deweerdt.

SOONER INVOLVEMENT IN THE PROJECT

While in the past Masterveil was mainly asked to apply the system to cold stores and freezer rooms, engineering offices are now looking to the technology at a much earlier stage. "Engineering offices are already calling upon us for construction or conversion projects at an early stage in their projects, something that is an extremely positive evolution. We are also seeing interest in our revolutionary system from abroad growing strongly."

With large areas of cooling and freezer space in Bavikhove (West Flanders) and at the Port of Ghent, Mipa Frost is an attractive gateway for importers of deep-frozen or fresh products. "The products go straight from the ship into our freezers or cold stores, ready for further transport to wherever the customer wishes", says founder and business manager Pascal Braecke.

Mipa Frost grew out of Braecke Trading, a company trading in potatoes and other vegetables. Pasca Braecke explains more: "We have 4,000 pallet spaces in Bavikhove, while in the port at Ghent we have a further 75,000 m³ of storage space available. We have both deep-freeze and refrigerated zones at temperatures of 2 to 4 degrees Celsius. In the port at Ghent we are also excellently equipped for the loading and unloading of reefer containers. When required we also assist our customers with customs formalities and any necessary prior and further transport."

HIGH INVESTMENTS

In 2015 Mipa Frost will be investing heavily in an automated warehouse management system with remote stock monitoring. "We mainly store fresh vegetables, butter products, deep-frozen fries, potato products and deep-frozen meat. Besides potato and other vegetables producers in Belgium, we are also strongly targeting import companies."


